- 2. Curriculum Vitae
- 3. A current copy of your UCLA academic transcripts. **NOTE:** Unofficial transcripts issued from Murphy Hall or electronic printout from a personal computer will be accepted.

All applicants who wish to TA for CCAS must have completed or in progress graduate course 495: Learner-Centered Teaching in Chicana/o and Central American Studies.

Important Notice:

Pursuant to Article 11 - Fee Remission, eligible graduate student employees appointed at 25% or greater are entitled to 100% remission of tuition and eligible fees charged. The fees included in the fee remission are the: (1) Student Services Fee, (2) premium for the Student Health Insurance Program (SHIP), and (3) partial fee remission of \$100 toward campus fees as set forth in the collective bargaining agreement [<<For #3, for Fall 2023 and later, replace with "100% partial fee remission toward campus fees as set forth in the collective bargaining agreement>>]. UC will cover Nonresident Supplemental Tuition for up to three (3) years for eligible ASEs employed at 25% or greater who have advanced to candidacy in their degree program.
